
LOCATION: Hadlow

Hadlow. The village offers a post office/convenience store, grocers/off-licence, hair dressers, pharmacy, village bakers, medical centre and primary school. There is also a vintage homeware shop with cafe and Kent's only rural and land-based college, Hadlow College.

Tonbridge town offers an excellent range of retail and leisure activities with many High Street stores, together with a selection of coffee shops, restaurants and local inns.

The mainline station provides fast commuter links into London (Cannon Street/London Bridge/Charing Cross in approximately 40 minutes) with road links to the M20 & M25 motorways via the nearby A26 and A21.

Tonbridge offers first-rate primary and secondary schools (including Grammars and Public Schools) many of which consistently do well in the league tables. There are many places of historical interest in the surrounding areas including Penshurst Place and Gardens, Hever Castle, Knole House and Chartwell (once home to Winston Churchill).





